Opportunities for Support

The Conference is a two day event, with the first day featuring a Health Fair for the Elderly, and the second day a Conference by Service Providers to the Elderly, to address pressing issues for the Elderly, and explore possible solutions. A featured discussion is a presentation by the Texas University Longhorn Council on how Young Adults can team up with the Texas Elderly and assist in addressing and perhaps resolving these issues.

There are opportunities for Major Sponsors, with Gold Sponsors providing at least \$5,000; Silver Sponsors providing at least \$3,500; and Bronze Sponsors providing at least \$2,500.
