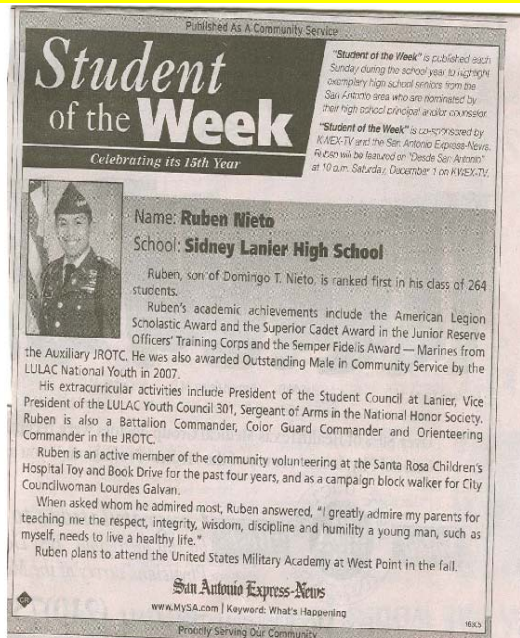
301 goes to City Hall
